Excellent Research Infrastructures



Horizon20202 call INFRADEV-3-2016

- Individual support to ESFRI and other world-class research infrastructures
 - will target the long-term sustainability of new research infrastructures, ESFRI and other world-class research infrastructures in Europe,
 - with established governance and legal structure, notably on the basis of the European Research Infrastructure Consortium (ERIC) or any other suitable structure.
 - Support will be provided to activities aimed at ensuring long-term sustainability, including enlargement of the membership, European coverage, international cooperation
 - to increase reliability and create trust, definition of service level agreements and business/funding plan, outreach, and technology transfer activities. 50 month (!) project
 - support progress towards the development of global research infrastructures

CSA Coordination and support action

- support coordination and networking activities
 - to investigate the feasibility and/or prepare for innovations
- Deadline was 30 March 2016
 - Same as e.g. RadioNet & AENEAS
 - Selected August 26

Joining up Users for Maximising the Profile, the Innovation and the Necessary Globalisation of JIVE


- Should actually focus on the "EVN" Research Infrastructure

Grant agreement

- Between EC and coordinator ()IVE)
 - representing the other parties
- Action to be implemented, described in Annex
 - Financial obligations, what are eligible costs
 - Use of resources to implement the Action
 - How to show progress, deliverables, reports & reviews
 - Ownership of the results, dissemination
 - Rights & obligation, ethical issues

Consortium agreement arranges:

- How this consortium of organisations runs
 - Responsibilities in the consortium, liabilities
 - Governance: board, executive, management
 - Results, access rights, background
 - •Statements by CNRS, Chalmers, TUM, UMAN
 - •Includes affiliated Leeds IP Limited

First focus on CA



- Project Board
 - All partner represented with equal voice
 - Meets at least once a year
 - 2/3 of Members should be represented
 - Can take decisions by 2/3 majority
- Executive
 - Work-Package leaders + coordinator
 - Meets >5 times a year
- And Management team
 - At Coordinator
- Note: several of us will be having multiple roles
 - Idea is to keep this small and efficient
