Plenary announcements: EVN Symposium very good, many directors and young people to chat with, mm-VLBI developments and results are booming: tri-band receivers and frequency-phase-transfer (and source-frequency-phase-transfer) huge impact, ambitious plans in countries surrounding us: RASOR (UK)=10-12 SKA-MID dishes in UK, 3-4 w/ LOFAR station for space weather & ionospheric monitoring, LEVERAGE(DE)=4 ngVLA dishes in Germany as outstations to ngVLA and SKA-MID, can operate "solo".

#824: EEE upgrade — same state as before PaulB's holiday #1074: tape library evaluation — MarkK, AardK, others given access, no feedback yet

#1077: no old stuff on the network — some hosts upgraded over the past few weeks, remaining to do evn-monitor, followed by code.jive.eu, then db0

#1078: "monitoring" — want to migrate to Zabbix v7, need to check w/BobC, MartinL, PaulB, BobE _what_ needs to be monitored (for dashboard creation — red.); cannot guarantee all data, views, dashboards, can be migrated from old zabbix to new. Q: move to Postgres? Is faster and saves ~20% HDD space, also: Mattermost indicates dropping support for MySQL. [DesS: could have strategy ticket for migration to Postgres?] [PaulB: try on select instances first] gitea also sais it does not support MariaDB, at least not officially. [Note: issue is that MySQL is not in free O/S, can use MariaDB, but sometimes too old; MySQL == Oracle => before you know they'll come visiting counting CPUs and present licensing fee bill; some apps already using Postgres, evn—vo and at least one other, but also our queries may not be exactly migratable to Postgres, let alone some of the functionality we rely on)

#1118: archive script development — generate static HTML from db (done), DOI creation in progress but a bit worried that real DOI is *real* (e.g. creating a million = big problem) [Marjolein: that's why we have the sandbox environment, maybe make script capable of re-running and replace test-DOIs with the real thing after checking for correctness]

#686: new archive server — software migration completed & seems ok; remaining to do is hardware migration of tape + zombie jbod HDDs; need to plan downtime day to do this

[MarjoleinV: feedback from users in questionnaire, two most negative aspects are a) archive interface and b) pySCHED installation. But we know that wrt a) we've already got a working prototype for the new interface, was waiting for hardware migration and b) using conda + venv but still very tricky: Python installations break very easily on e.g. matplotlib and/or numpy and/or Qt]

[Q WybrenB: what about the UK flexbuff? And "the other flexbuff"?] [A MarjoleinV: UK flexbuff restarting now that holiday season is over, procedure requires availability of staff at both ends; was informed informally at EVN Symposium that HDDs for JohnMcK's flexbuff are now ordered so who knows]

[BobE: working on forwarded vulnerability reports on ASTRON tools by ICT caused by Responsible Disclosure clause on ASTRON website that affect our tools too: NorthStar (account takeover) and domain cookie-stealin' in EVN Calculator]
